- **Hear Any Public Comments and Communication**

Plans were made to remove the Japanese Barberry bush in front of the old Town Clerk Office on Friday June 28 at 1:30 pm. Volunteers are welcome.

Cindy Kilgore stated two cases of rabies have been confirmed in the valley. There was a discussion over organizing a special rabies clinic with other towns in a joint effort. Cindy has been busy contacting other town Health Officers, the State Dept. of Health and area veterinarians for information.

No action taken regarding revisions to Dog Ordinance.

The Selectboard gave their approval to allow a dog crate to be kept at the Granville General Store.

Vivian Branschofsky requested having her name added to the emailing of Select Board Meeting Agendas.

Victoria Crowne reviewed plans for updating the Town Website with minutes from the Conservation Committee and their meeting dates.

Mike Eramo reported that the road signs recently purchased by the Town were stolen. Mike also notified the board the culvert replacement will and road closure will be extended into the first week of July. This is due to the heavy rain causing the stream to rise making it unsafe for a period of time, causing a delay in completion.

- **Financial Management**

All Select Board, Highway and Cemetery Orders were approved.

The Select Board discussed two Road Structure Grant applications. Kevin stated the need to widen the bottom of Plunkton Road. The board felt this would cause a negative impact on commuters while all the current Route 100 road work is being done and because it would interrupt this alternate route. The second application is for a culvert replacement. The board felt the application was incomplete and needed more information on both proposed projects.

**Jaqueline Hammond moved to table the Road Structures Grant applications until more information is given. The motion was seconded by Victoria Crowne. All in favor none opposed. Victoria Crowne moved to accept the minutes from Town Meeting 2013. Motion was seconded by Jacqueline Hammond. All in favor and none opposed.**

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Continued:

**Three loans were presented for approval. One is to extend the Flood Restoration Loan for one year. The second is a Loan in Anticipation of Tax to be collected and the third loan is for an Anticipation of Highway Grant. Victoria Crowne moved to approve the three loans. Motion was seconded by Cheryl Sargeant. All in favor and none opposed.**

The Treasurer was directed to apply for reimbursement for payment made to outside appraisals done on the HMGP properties.

The Board discussed with homeowner in Buy Out program, the procedure for reimbursement and the current status for moving trailer off site.

- **New Business**

The Select Board approved a contract with White River Valley Ambulance.

Lister Grievance Hearings will be held on June 19, 2013.

Judy Wood submitted a written request to have the barn board on the shed of one of the properties slated for for Buy Out. **Victoria Crowne moved to allow Judy to take the barn boards but not until after the closing. Motion was seconded by Jaqueline Hammond. All in favor and none opposed.**
