Old Business:

- Feasibility of Questionnaire – Judy made the motion to abandon mailing a questionnaire due to lack of PC funds, and Mary seconded. All in favor none opposed.
- Proposed project to amend the Town Plan will gather public opinion through Survey Monkey. Cheryl will notify the community through the Granville Town News e-mail list and a news article in the Herald of Randolph along with posters and a news flash on the Town website. Mary made the motion to have Judy draft the survey and work with Mark Deslauriers to set up on Survey Monkey and Cheryl seconded. All in favor none opposed.
- Discussed bill S.230 which would give Vermont communities more input into the Public Service Board's review process of proposed renewable energy projects. Cheryl informed the group that the Governor just vetoed the bill. The Legislature will be reconvening later this week to see if they can override the veto or redraft the bill.
- Judy will contact Chris Sargeant of Two Rivers to check on what material might be deleted from the Town Plan, in the proposed amendment process, to make the plan more concise and more relevant to the Town of Granville.
- Discussed placing the meeting minutes in the Herald of Randolph. Mary made the motion not to do this monthly, but rather to publish important project information as needed. Cheryl seconded. All in favor none opposed.
