We came up with the idea of including questions as part of the report as a means of garnering public input, and Judy will add them. Judy will also request time at Town Meeting to present our report and to urge people to respond to the report's questions.
- We reviewed the entire amendment project for Marilyn and Sean, both of whom made excellent suggestions for getting public input. Also, reviewed PC communication with the Conservation Commission and its poor results. But Marilyn will bring this up at the next CC meeting and see if the Conservation Commission would be willing to help.
- Judy updated us on the still not finalized ACT 174 regulations and shared info she'd gleaned about renewable energy credits. She also explained that the particular Docket 8652 requirement which had seemed to be in conflict with Act 174 was only relevant to a certain set of energy project proposals whose time window for applications had already closed.

New Business:

Judy and Cheryl will make a trip to East Granville to see if there are any possible sites for renewable energy projects along the Route 12A corridor.

Judy made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:00p.m. And Cheryl seconded. All in favor none opposed.
