Recent History Lesson from Norm: 13 public roads added in the Ancient Roads Initiative in 2010. Many were public trails for recreation and class 4 roads. We are able to keep access to those roads as a result and can use them for recreation.

1 road was rejected, to a school but the land survey was not found in the town records

Work to be completed by Parks and Recreation Committee:

- Erosion work on ancient roads needs to be identified, planned, budgeted, and completed.
- It is most needed to establish recreation.

Erica: Proposed that the area directly around the town hall made more obvious as a recreation area. Have a trail head near the parking area, a kiosk of information and trail maps, make the area more welcoming. **Proposed plan for a Granville Post Office to be voted on during Town Meeting Day may influence plans.

Sean: Proposed working with national forest service to make a through trail on western slope road

- Need to be able to maintain it
- Show maps of intended project
- National parks service won't maintain new trails
- Make a couple of ski glades on east facing hill?

Erica: Proposed linking bike trail to Rasta. Foreseeable problems getting permission from landowners to build and maintain access to their property for such a trail.

Things to Achieve in 2017:

Soccer field, picnic space around Town Hall

- Erica volunteered to start making the town hall area more inviting.
- Explore funding opportunities with Rasta, DisasTour

Sean: Will head up petitioning the forest service to make new trails, ski area.

Green Up day – do maintenance on new Bagley trail. – Remove any hazardous, dangerous items off of trails. (in May, plan in April)

Plan action items for 2018, create a budget, ask for town funding next year.
