IT IS ESTIMATED THAT THIS PROPOSED BUDGET IF APPROVED, WILL RESULT IN EDUCATION SPENDING OF \$19,588.09 PER EQUALIZED PUPIL. THIS PROJECTED SPENDING PER EQUALIZED PUPIL IS 4.38% LOWER THAN SPENDING FOR THE CURRENT YEAR.
